Dear Sodium Hypochlorite Customer:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has passed new rules for producers who use refillable containers for certain pesticides. Sodium Hypochlorite sold by Harcros Chemicals Inc. in returnable Intermediate Bulk Containers (IBC's) fall under these new rules.

The new rules include a requirement for each opening on a refillable container to have a one-way valve, tamper-evident seal, or both. Furthermore, unless a container is returned to the producer with all one-way valves and tamper-evident seals intact, the container must be cleaned before being refilled.

The new rules become effective August, 2011. Harcros will be ready to supply our valuable customers with returnable IBC's that meet the new requirements well before the effective date. These new IBC's will have a bottom outlet valve with a built in check valve. All top openings will include a wire seal that must be cut before they can be removed. An automatic vent will allow users to withdraw material up to 70 GPM without disturbing any top opening. If even faster withdrawal rates are required, a small manual vent in the top can be opened without breaking the seals.

Harcros will impose a \$100 cleaning fee for each new returnable IBC where the customer has tampered with an outlet valve or broken a tamper-evident seal. Before Harcros can ship Sodium Hypochlorite to you in these new refillable IBC's, you must sign below certifying you agree with these terms. When a Harcros driver picks up these IBC's, they will inspect all openings. If all valves and seals are intact, they will provide you with a signed form indicating you will not be subject to a cleaning fee. Please keep that form for your records.
